2. SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

i. Ph.D Programmes

Applicants seeking admission to the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) programmes must hold an academic master's degree from Bingham University or any other recognized institution, with a minimum CGPA of 3.50 on a 5.00 scale, and submit a research synopsis that addresses a specific research gap.

Alternatively, applicants with a specific interest in artifact or product development may be considered for our new Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) by Product in Physics, Computer Science, or Architecture. To qualify for this track, applicants must meet the same masters degree and CGPA requirements and submit an academically robust research proposal that addresses tangible societal challenges in the areas specified at this link.

ii. MPhil/Ph.D Programmes

Applicants holding an academic master's degree from Bingham University or any other recognized institution with a CGPA below 3.50 but not less than 3.00 on a 5.00 scale may be considered for the MPhil/Ph.D. program.

Applicants holding a professional master's degree from Bingham University or any other recognized institution must have a minimum CGPA of 3.75 on a 5.00 scale to be considered for the MPhil/Ph.D. program.

iii. Masters Programmes

a) Academic Masters: Applicants for academic master programmes with a first degree from Bingham University, or any other recognized University, must possess a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) in the relevant field, or a relevant Postgraduate Diploma with a minimum CGPA of 3.00 from Bingham University or any recognized University.

b) Professional Masters: Applicants for professional master's degree must possess a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) degree in the relevant area from Bingham University Karu, or any recognized university. A postgraduate diploma in the relevant area not below classification of lower credit from Bingham University or any recognized university could be considered.

iii. Postgraduate Diploma Programmes

An applicant seeking admission into any postgraduate diploma programme must possess a qualification equivalent to a first degree (at least 3rd Class Degree or higher) or a Higher National Diploma (with at least Lower Credit) or its equivalent.

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. All applicants must have five (5) O'Level credit passes, in the required subjects, including Mathematics and English.
2. Applicants must complete the Application Form online and upload scanned copies of their credentials, such as their National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) Discharge or Exemption Certificate.
3. Transcripts of Academic Records should be forwarded to: The Secretary, School of Postgraduate Studies, Km 26, Bingham University, Karu, Nasarawa State.
4. Applicants are to obtain three (3) letters of Reference and forward same to the above address. The reference letters must come from persons who have either taught or worked with them.
5. A printed copy of the completed Application Form and copies of credentials should also be submitted at the School of Postgraduate Studies.

4. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application forms are available online subject to the payment of a non-refundable fee for the programme of interest as follows:
